Summer is here and you are going on holiday with friends or family! But it's always worth making careful preparations before a trip. Here are some things to think about.

1. Travel light! You don't want to carry a heavy suitcase around. Remember you can always wash clothes by hand, and in summer they dry quickly. Make a list of everything you need. Don't forget: rain clothes, sun cream, your phone charger and a small first aid kit. These things could also be useful if you have room: a water bottle and, if you are going abroad, a travel guide with common phrases in another language.
2. Pay attention to your personal safety – keep an eye out for pickpockets on public transport and don't walk alone after dark. In other countries, the rules of the road may be different. Cars may drive on the other side of the road, or they may not stop for you when you cross the road.
3. Take care of yourself! You can easily get ill when you are in a new place because your body needs time to adjust to the food, water and air in a new environment. In many places it is better to avoid drinking or brushing your teeth with tap water. Drink only bottled water. Peel or wash fruit and vegetables and only eat street food that has been freshly prepared in front of you.
4. In hot countries, avoid the sun in the hottest times of the day (11 am to 3 pm). Wear a T-shirt when you go swimming to protect your back and shoulders. Drink plenty of water – about three litres a day.
5. It is a good idea to read up about the culture of a country you are going to visit, so you understand the differences. In some places, shorts and T-shirts in public are not liked, especially for women. Perhaps, people don't shake hands when they greet each other – in parts of Asia they bow, for example. Eating and food can sometimes be a problem: does each person have an individual meal or are there large plates in the middle of the table for everybody to help themselves?
